Water Audit II Webinar preparation

Recommended Materials:

- Water Audit: If you have a completed water audit, please have that available for review. Also consider downloading a copy of the [AWWA Water Audit \(v5\)](#) software (the AWWA website requires you to login to download the software – creating a login is easy and free).
- [WRF Component Analysis](#): visit the Water Research Foundation to download the Leakage Component Analysis Model (located at the bottom under project resources). Also consider reviewing the Real loss research reports and the leak repair data collection guide.
- Computer (required): Ideally try to have a large monitor or a laptop to allow viewing the software and webinar at the same time. [Check your system requirements](#) (open link on the computer you will use).
- Audio: you can use your computer audio or a phone to listen to the webinar. Attendees will be muted, so a computer microphone is not necessary (just speakers).

Webinar Support:

- Software preparation time: To attend the webinar you will need to run the go-to-webinar application. This will require that you download the application (perhaps even if it has been previously installed on your computer).
